In addition, with the increased reliability of inventory management using the HighJump system, Kirkland's reduced inventory levels in its stores. Prior to system implementation, each store had an offsite warehouse to act as a buffer for irregular shipments. Kirkland's has now eliminated more than 90 percent of its offsite storage locations through regular, planned shipments.

Kirkland's recently benefited from the visibility and inventory accuracy of its HighJump system during a physical inventory audit required for Sarbanes-Oxley compliance. "This was the best physical inventory I've ever been associated with.
