

Seoul National University to Install 3M Detection and SelfCheck Systems at Central Library and Seven Branches

Seoul National University (SNU), one of South Korea's largest and most respected institutions of higher education, will install detection and SelfCheck systems from 3M Library Systems at its Central Library and seven branches. Installation is expected to be completed this month.
