3M Awards Ingenuity Grants to 32 Area Schools For Math and Science Projects

Mahtomedi – 10 grants for a total of \$33,836 North St. Paul/Maplewood/Oakdale – 8 grants for a total of \$21,791 St. Paul – 14 grants for a total of \$37,339 South Washington County – 26 grants for a total of \$81,831 Stillwater – 3 grants for a total of \$8,386 White Bear Lake – 4 grants for a total of \$11,842

This year, the 3M Foundation, through the Ingenuity Grant program, is giving a total of \$551,555 in 185 grants in 21 states. In the eight years of the program, 811 grants totaling over \$2.2 million have been awarded nationally.
